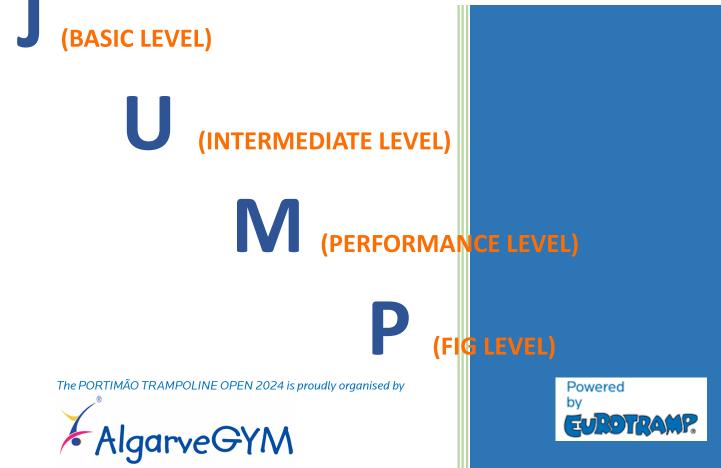

- \* Each team is composed of only 3 or 4 elements.

#### **QUALIFYING**

\* The qualifying round will take place at the same time as the qualifying rounds of the individual competitions.

\* The 5 teams with the highest score in the qualifiers will compete in the team final.

#### FINALS

\* In this final will compete 3 gymnasts of the team and the event will take place in direct confrontation of the gymnasts.

\* 30 min before the start of the event, each team coach will hand the order of competition of their trampolinists to the technical direction.

\* On each round, a gymnast from each team will compete and each team will score from 1 to 5 according to their final score (5 for the highest score, 4 for the second highest, and so on, down to the score of 1 for the lowest one).

\* Points will be accounted at the end of each round.

\* At the end of the 5 rounds, the teams' standings will be the sum of the points earned of the 5 rounds.

\* The team with the highest points wins the event.

\* In the event of a tie, the team with the highest total score of all routines wins.

## **ALL-AROUND**



#### ALL-AROUND

\* This competition will be held only for gymnasts who compete at level U, M and P, and in the age groups 15-16, 17-21 and 17+.

\* This competition will be mixed sex, joining together the individual trampoline, synchronized trampoline and double-minitrampoline events.

\* Each club can only register two teams, each with a minimum of 4 (2W and 2M).

#### **QUALIFYING**

\* The qualifying round will take place simultaneously with the individual competitions' qualifying rounds.

\* After the qualifying round, the final score of each team will be the sum of the trampolinists' scores, in the individual events, and the pairs' scores in the synchronized trampoline event. (TRI W, TRI M, DMT W, DMT M, TRS W e TRS M).

\* In Individual Trampoline, the best V2 of the gymnasts in the team, of each gender will be considered.

\* In Synchronized Trampoline, the best F2, of the different pairs in the team, of each gender, will be considered.

\* In Double-Minitrampoline, the best final score (F1+F2), of the different gymnasts in the team, of each gender, will be considered.

\* The 5 teams with the highest total scores will compete in the All-around Team Final.

\* Any team composition changes must be communicated to the technical direction up to 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the Finals and may or may not be accepted.

\* This event will only be held if there are at least 5 teams entered.

#### FINALS

\* The All-around Team Final consists of one routine by trampolinist or pair, in each of the events.

\* There will be three rounds of competition in the Final, in the following manner:

1st Round: TRI W – DMT M

2nd Round: TRI M – DMT W

3th Round: TRS W – TRS M

\* The final ranking in each round is converted into points as follows:

1st place - 5 points

2nd place - 4 points

3th place - 3 points

4th place - 2 points

5th place - 1 points

\* The Team with the highest number of points in the end is declared the winner of the All-Around Team Competition of the Portimão Trampoline Open 2024.

\* In the event of a tie, the team with the highest total score of all series wins.
